

MEi:CogSci Alumni newsletter for 2020/21


Dear coxies,

Another year passed, and it was not an easy one. Despite the situation, the program went well. Read on about our activities.

Study

The study was marked by the Corona crisis. We succeeded to see our students face to face for two weeks in September and then everything went online for the rest of the year.





Check out our <u>current curriculum</u>. The final exams were combined, with some students being present physically, some online. From three terms (February, June, August) we have got six new graduates — Danijela, Klara, Michal, Barbora, Lucia and Jana — congratulations and welcome to the Mei:CogSciBA alumni family! Entrance exams in June took place online. We had 32 applications from 16 countries,

out of which we accepted 22. To these days, 14 students from 10 countries (Slovakia, Czech Republic, Russia, Colombia, Serbia, Austria, Iran, Turkey, Italy, Germany) enrolled in the first year.

We hosted 12 mobility students (4 Ljubljana, 8 Vienna).

Conferences

The 2021 MEi:CogSci conference was again organized virtually, with a turnout of approx. 150 people.

The annual Czech-Slovak conference KUZ (Cognition and artificial life) was canceled again due to corona. We do hope that the next year will resume the tradition of the conference, meeting the wonderful Czech and Slovak cognitive science community face to face.

Our team at Department of Applied Informatics was also involved in organizing a prestigious international conference on neural networks (ICANN) collocated with Bratislava Knowledge September 2021. The conference was held in online format.

Life

We were also active toward general public, mainly through the Slovak Cognitive Science Society (SSKV). The summary of SSKV activities is <u>here</u>.
